Registering

In order to participate in the course, you can visit the project website www.socetner.eu or go straight to the e-learning platform www.moodle.socenter.eu



To create an account, write an e-mail to biuro@zofiazamenhof.pl with your name and e-mail address. In the subject line of the e-mail, please write “Request for login information - SocEnter”.

The administrator will create an account for you in a timely manner and send your login information in response to your email address. The response will be sent to you within no more than 24 hours after requesting your login data.

With this login data, you will be able to log into the platform and start the course.
